1. **banner** (noun) A banner is a kind of flag with words on it.
2. **bare** (adj) If something is bare, it is not covered by anything.
3. **calf** (noun) 1. The back part of your leg between the ankle and the knee. 2. A young cow or bull.
4. **dash** (verb) To go somewhere very quickly. (noun) A very small amount.
5. **demolish** (verb) If you demolish something, you tear it down or destroy it.
6. **dome** (noun) A roof that is in the shape of an upside-down bowl.
7. **dozen** (noun) 12 of something.
8. **fold** (verb) To bend something over. (noun) The mark left on something when it is bent over on itself.
9. **herd** (noun) A group of animals that move and eat together.
10. **soil** (noun) Dirt that plants grow in.

1. **center** (noun) 1. The place in the middle of something. 2. The most important part.
2. **couple** (noun) 1. A small number of things; usually two. 2. Two people who are dating or are married.
3. **dangerous** (adj) Something not safe.
4. **discard** (verb) To throw it away.
5. **harm** (verb) If something harms you, it hurts you.
6. **leader** (noun) Someone who shows or tells people what to do.
7. **pack** (verb) To put things into a bag, box, or suitcase. (noun) A group of animals or things.
8. **safe** (adj) Not in danger of being harmed or stolen. (noun) A box that holds money or valuables.
9. **support** (verb) 1. To hold something up. 2. To help someone out. (noun) Something used to hold an object up.
10. **yard** (noun) 1. The land around a building. 2. A length that is the same as three feet, or 36 inches.

1. **act** (verb) 1. To do something. 2. To play a part in a movie, play or TV show.
(noun) 1. Something that is done. 2. A part of a play or show.
2. **certain** (adj) 1. Being positive or confident about something. 2. A specific or different thing.
3. **clever** (adj) Being smart in an interesting way; creative.
4. **explore** (verb) . To go somewhere and look around.
5. **habit** (noun) . Something that someone does a lot.
6. **locate** (verb) . To find out where something is. Related word: **location**. (noun) The place where something is.
7. **opposite** (adj) . Very different from something else. (noun) Something that is very different from something else.
8. **starve** (verb) . To suffer or die from not having enough food to eat.
9. **talent** (noun) . A natural skill for doing something well.
10. **treasure** (noun) . Something very valuable and worth a lot. (verb) To care a lot about something.

1. **ambition** (noun) A strong desire to be good at something or to have something.
2. **cable** (noun) A thick metal rope, or electrical wires covered in plastic.
3. **convince** (verb) To make someone believe something.
4. **crumple** (verb) To crush together into folds and wrinkles.
5. **fatal** (adj) Deadly; causing death.
6. **globe** (noun) The planet Earth, or a ball-shaped map of the planet Earth.
7. **grace** (noun) Beauty, or a pleasing quality. Related word: **graceful**. (adj) Being beautiful; having grace.
8. **intend** (verb) . To mean to do something or try to do something.
9. **responsible** (adj) . 1. To be in charge of something or take credit for something. 2. Trustworthy.
10. **thrill** (noun) A sudden feeling of excitement (adj) To give someone a sudden feeling of excitement.

1. **brilliant** (adj) . 1. Very smart and intelligent. 2. Shining; very bright.
2. **capture** (verb) . To take by force, or to grab and hold on to something.
3. **continent** (noun) One of seven large areas of land on the earth.
4. **crew** (noun) A group of people working together.
5. **doze** (verb) . To fall asleep for a short time; nap.
6. **perform** (verb) . 1. To carry out a task. 2. To act or entertain.
7. **plunge** (verb) . To dive into; to fall down quickly.
8. **predator** (noun) . An animal that eats other animals; the opposite of prey.
9. **primary** (adj) First in importance or order.
10. **wander** (verb) . To move or walk around without going straight to something.
